

## **Homelessness Kills**

The process used to identify people is the same each year—a wide range of organizations that work with people struggling to have housing security share names of people who have experienced significant difficulty to have adequate housing and have died. Names are cross-referenced to eliminate duplications. People have not in most cases died directly on the street from homelessness (for example, weather exposure or assault) but have died where there is a determination they would have not died as soon if they consistently had adequate housing.

Names of people who have died are not released.
